### 2. Description

On the basis of Association Council decisions or Framework Agreements, candidate countries may participate in certain European Union programmes and agencies.

Pre-accession financial assistance can be used to help a candidate country to meet part of the costs of participation in those programmes and agencies, on the basis of an increasing contribution from the Candidate Country. A maximum of 10% of Pre-accession financial assistance available for national programme funding may be used to co-finance participation in Union programmes and agencies. Participation in the R&D Programme does not count towards the 10% limit.

The Framework Agreement between Turkey and the European Community on the General Principles for the Participation of Turkey in Community Programmes was signed on 26 February 2002, and entered into force on 5 September 2002. Thus, Turkey's participation in a number of programmes is being materialized through separate Memoranda of Understanding.

Normally, the EU's grant assistance will be made available each year for Turkey so as to cofinance the financial contribution to be paid by Turkey to participate in the programmes and agencies in the following year.

This project fiche for the **2010 Financing Agreement** shows EU support for Turkey's participation, *inter alia*, in the programmes and agencies listed in the table below for the year **2011.** 

### 3. Detailed Budget

### 4. Implementation Arrangements

- **4.1**. The National Fund is responsible for the allowable Pre-accession financial assistance share of the financial contribution to be paid by the country to participate in Union programmes and agencies
- **4.2** Upon signature of the Financing Agreement, the National Fund will request from the Commission the transfer of the full amount<sup>2</sup> of Pre-accession financial assistance indicated in section 3 above. These funds must be used to pay the EU share of the financial contribution to be paid by Turkey to participate in Union programmes and agencies.

Turkey shall pay its total financial contribution indicated in section 3 above in the column "total cost" as stipulated in the relevant Memorandum of Understanding signed between Turkey and the European Commission.

**4.3** The various Commission services responsible for the different programmes or agencies will send to the Permanent Delegation of Turkey to the EU a request for the total financial contribution for the participation in a given programme or agency ("call for funds"). The National Fund should check the amount to be financed from Pre-accession financial assistance funds and then transfer the amount as per the call for funds to the Commission service responsible. When making the payment for each programme, the National Fund should quote the reference number indicated in the call for funds for the programme concerned, and send simultaneously a copy of the payment order to the relevant Commission service.

### **Observations/Remarks**

### a. European Environment Agency (EEA)

Turkey has decided to allocate % 30 IPA assistance for her participation fee to the **European Environment Agency (EEA)** in 2011.

#### b. Programme for Employment and Social Solidarity (PROGRESS):

The MoU for Turkey's participation in the **Programme for Employment and Social Solidarity** (**PROGRESS**) was signed on 17.10.2007, and its ratification was completed on 20 June 2009.

## c. European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction (EMCDDA)

The agreement between Turkey and the EC on the participation of Turkey in the **European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction** was signed on 30.10.2007, but at the time of writing this Project Fiche, the MoU was yet to be ratified. Therefore, the participation fees as foreseen in the agreement were taken as basis and it was assumed that the first year of actual participation was 2010. Therefore, an allocation was made on the assumption that 2011 is the second year of participation.

#### d. Competitiveness and Innovation Framework Programme 2007-2013 (CIP)

The MoU for Turkey's participation in the EIP component was signed on 12.02.2008 and entered into force on 22.01.2009. Turkey has decided to allocate % 30 IPA assistance for its participation fee to the EIP leg of the "Competitiveness and Innovation Framework Programme 2007-2013.

#### e. Customs 2013

The Fiche assumes that % 30 of Turkey's participation fee would be co-financed from EU funds.

#### f. 7th Framework Programme

It has been agreed with DG Enlargement that the remaining funds from the overall programming can be used towards Turkey's participation fee for this program.

The participation fee shown on this Fiche takes into account the total sum of  $7^{th}$  Framework and EURATOM. However, note that if the Memorandum of Understanding regarding EURATOM is not signed/approved in 2011, then the Fiche will need to be revised to reflect participation fee to  $7^{th}$  Framework Programme alone (this figure is  $71.670.018 \rightleftharpoons$ )

# g. CIP-ICT:

The draft Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 26.05.2009 so as to cover the participation of Turkey in the programme as from 1 January 2009. Turkey has decided to allocate 30 % EU assistance for her participation fee to the CIP-ICT in 2011.

## **Conclusion:**

Regarding Turkey's participation in Union Programs and Agencies in 2011, the table in the Fiche is an indicative estimate showing the related participation fees and their co-financing from EU funds.

These figures will need to be allocated between the above-mentioned programmes, depending on the financial conditions to be laid out in the relevant Memoranda of Understanding. Should Turkey decide not to participate in one or more of these new-generation programmes, part of this lump sum allocation which will then be available could also be added on to the EU support for the 7<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme (including EURATOM upon the signature of the related MoU), or if the need should arise for any contingency purpose, or for any other Program as well as any new Programs Turkey may decide to participate in.
