THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1085/2006 establishing an Instrument of Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA)<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 14(2) (b) thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) Regulation (EC) No 1085/2006 lays down the objectives and main principles for preaccession assistance to candidate and potential candidate countries for the period from 2007 to 2013.
- (2) In accordance with Article 155 of Commission Regulation (EC) No 718/2007 implementing Council Regulation No 1085/2006<sup>2</sup>, the assistance under the Regional Development and Human Resources Development components should be implemented through multi-annual operational programmes.
- (3) These programmes should be drawn up in accordance with the general policy framework referred to in Article 4 of Regulation (EC) No 1085/2006, the applicable multi-annual indicative financial framework referred to in Article 5 of that Regulation and the relevant multi-annual indicative planning documents referred to in Article 6 of that Regulation.
- (4) The Council has established an European Partnership for the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia<sup>3</sup>.
- (5) The Commission adopted on 8 November 2006 the multi-annual indicative financial framework for 2008 to 2010<sup>4</sup>, confirming the 2007 allocations.
- (6) The Commission adopted on 30 April 2007 the multi-annual indicative planning document for the years 2007-2009 for the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia which presents the main priorities for pre-accession assistance to this country.

- (7) On 11 July 2007, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia submitted to the Commission a strategic coherence framework, based on that multi-annual indicative planning document, which, pursuant to Article 154(1) of Regulation (EC) No 718/2007, constitutes a reference document for the programming of the Regional Development and Human Resources Development components.
- (8) On 20 July 2007, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia submitted to the Commission a proposal for a multi-annual operational programme "Regional Development" for Regional Development in this country.
- (9) The proposed operational programme has been drawn up by the operating structures in the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia in close consultation with the Commission and the relevant stakeholders.
- (10) The proposed operational programme contains all the elements referred to in Article 155(2) of Regulation (EC) No 718/2007 and is consistent with all the multi-annual documents referred to in Recitals 3 to 7. The draft programme contains, in particular, a description of the chosen strategic priority axes and the related measures chosen for assistance and an indicative financial table plan, specifying for each year covered by the applicable multi-annual indicative financial framework, and for each priority axis, the total amount of the Community contribution, the corresponding national contribution, where applicable identifying other external contributions, as well as the resulting rate of the Community contribution.
- (11) It is appropriate to set the maximum indicative amount of the Community contribution to the operational programme and the subsequent maximum co-financing rate for each priority axis, as referred to in Article 38(2) of Regulation (EC) No 718/2007.
- (12) In accordance with Article 8(1) of Regulation (EC) No 718/2007 this decision meets the requirements of Article 90 of Commission Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 2342/2002 of 23 December 2002 laying down detailed rules for the implementation of Council Regulation No 1605/2002<sup>6</sup> and constitutes thus a financing decision within the meaning of Article 75 (2) of Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 1605/2002 of 25 June 2002 on the Financial Regulation applicable to the general budget of the European Communities<sup>7</sup>.
- (13) The Coordination Committee of the Funds referred to in Article 103 of Regulation (EC) No 1083/2006 laying down general provisions on the European Regional Development Fund, the European Social Fund and the Cohesion Fund and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1260/1999<sup>8</sup>, which pursuant to Article 14(2) (b) of Regulation (EC) 1085/2006 shall assist the Commission, expressed its favourable opinion on the proposed operational programme.
- (14) The proposed operational programme should therefore be adopted.

#### HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

#### Article 1

The operational programme "Regional Development" for Community assistance under the IPA Regional Development component in the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia as set out in Annex I and containing the following priority axes is hereby approved:

- (a) Priority Axis 1: Corridor X Motorway Completion;
- (b) Priority Axis 2: Upgrading and Modernization of the Transport Infrastructure;
- (c) Priority Axis 3: Improvement of Environmental Infrastructure;
- (d) Priority Axis 4: Technical Assistance.

#### Article 2

1. The maximum indicative amount of the Community contribution from IPA under the operational programme, as calculated with reference to the public expenditure, is set at EUR 40,500,000.

In the budget year 2007, a maximum amount of EUR 7,400,000 may be committed on budget line 13.05.02.

In the budget year 2008, a maximum amount of EUR 12,300,000 may be committed on budget line 13.05.02.

In the budget year 2009, a maximum amount of EUR 20,800,000 may be committed on budget line 13.05.02.

2. The maximum amount of the Community contribution and the resulting co-financing rate for each priority axis under the operational programme shall be as set out in the second, third and fourth subparagraphs.

The maximum amount of the Community contribution for Priority Axis 1 Corridor X Motorway Completion is set at EUR 27,410,000 and the resulting co-financing rate is set at 45%.

The maximum amount of the Community contribution for Priority Axis 2 Upgrading and Modernization of the Transport Infrastructure is set at EUR 3,045,600 and the resulting co-financing rate is set at 75%.

The maximum amount of the Community contribution for Priority Axis 3 Improvement of Environmental Infrastructure is set at EUR 7,614,000 and the resulting co-financing rate is set at 75%.

The maximum amount of the Community contribution for Priority Axis 4 Technical Assistance is set at EUR 2,430,000 and the resulting co-financing rate is set at 75%.

3. The indicative list of Major Projects is set out in Annex II.

- 4. The corresponding financial table is set out in Annex III.
- 5. This financing decision covers the Community contribution for the years specified in Annex III and may be revised annually in accordance with the applicable multi-annual indicative financial framework and subject to budgetary availability.

### Article 3

The present decision will be implemented by means of a multi-annual Financing Agreement to be concluded between the Commission and the Government of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. This Financing Agreement shall cover the elements set out Article 8(4) of Regulation (EC) No 718/2007. In case, a Framework Agreement in the sense of Article 7 of that Regulation has not been concluded prior to the conclusion of the Financing Agreement, the latter shall in addition cover the elements set out in paragraph 3 of that Article.
